In order to be considered, students have to try their best, actively work on their projects, and show a true love and interest for art. The student who shows that they are working on art both in and outside of school and have a true passion for art will be in the running! The winner will be decided and announced at the end of each month.

# <u>Grades PreK - K</u>

We are currently getting the art groove back. Some of us are meeting for the first time and some of us have missed seeing each other over a year. We will be exploring our digital virtual classroom Mrs. I created and how artists use digital technology to create art. we will explore materials in art centers. In Pre K we will do an artist study on Eric Carl and how he created his book illustrations, while Kindergarten continues to explore color Line, shape and digital art programs.

# Grades 1-2

So excited to explore our virtual classroom I created for these special young artists. I know how much creative play means to them, so we will also get into a few hands-on projects for the first marking period while supporting our Social emotional learning and artistic studies.

# **Studio Art Class**

I'm sure these amazing art students are just as excited as I am to begin this year advanced art course. We will begin with learning google classroom as our digital platform for instruction and method of turning in our artwork. Then moving quickly into interactive digital sketchbooks where we will learn the elements of art with a focused-on color and form this year. After constructing a color wheel from our color theory study, we will move into drawing lessons that will culminate in a drawing from observation as a final portfolio piece. These students will also be creating ATC or artist trading cards. We will used these as homework and class assignments to stretch our use of materials, techniques and skill set. At the end of the year we will take part in a digital trade of our favorite cards.

# Grades 3-5

This year we will focused on a STEAM art connection, linking our art and technology studies to Science & Math subject areas. We will begin with understanding our Google classroom platform for instruction and shift to a hands-on problemsolving learning style. We will work digitally & with hands on materials. The students will also receive sketch books created by Mrs. I to use both in school and at home when necessary. I am excited to see what our future creative engineering minds discover this year.

## Grades 6-8

We are reaching deeper into our studies of art through the exploration of the elements of art and the principles of design. We will start out learning about these concepts through digital interactive sketchbooks and move to creating our own works of art based on these different artistic concepts. Then we will move to creating original projects based on a theme or skill set. We try to leave a lot of room for choice and personal interpretation of art in this level of art class.



### Art for the school year 2021-2022

This year due to our current COVID situation all art classes will be taught in person with masks. However, in the case we shift to remote learning the lessons will be taught digitally to all students. I encourage all students to join your art Google class during art periods and parents to add their contact information. This way we can share your creative minds with your fellow classmates whether we are in person or remote. I can't wait to share all the new and creative projects we will explore this year together.
